Invitation of Public Comments

Permission for laying of 33KV Electrical Cable (2 No. 4" Dia) through HDD Sub: method- crossing of NH-34 (Kanpur-Kabrai Section) at Ch. 0.000 to Ch. 2.160) (LHS) Naubasta bypass to Hanspuram Bamba, Kanpur in the State of Uttar Pradesh - reg.

The Assistant Engineer (Const.), Kanpur Electricity Supply Company Limited (KESCO) has submitted the proposal for permission for laying of 33KV Electrical Cable (2 No. 4" Dia) through HDD method- crossing of NH-34 (Kanpur-Kabrai Section) at Ch. 0.000 to Ch. 2.160) (LHS) Naubasta bypass to Hanspuram Bamba, Kanpur in the State of UP.

From the submitted proposal, it is seen that the length is proposed 2160m. Left 2. side from center line towards increasing chainage/ km direction is 20m and Right side from center line towards increasing chainage/ km direction is 20m. Diameter of the Electric line is 4" Dia each (2 Nos. line). Width of available ROW is 45m of the proposed location. The duct cable shall be laid close to the extreme edge i.e. at a distance of 15m from the centre line of the median.

As per the guidelines, issued by the Ministry vide OM No.RW/NH-33044/29/ 2015/ 3. S&R(R) dated 22.11.2016, the application shall be put out in the public domain for 30 days for seeking claims and objections (on grounds of public inconvenience, safety and general public interest).

4. In view of the above, comments of the public on the above application is invited to the below mentioned address, which should reach by this office within 30 days from the date of publication beyond which no comments shall be entertained.
