It is to inform all concern that the M/s. Torrent Gas Pvt. Ltd. Jaipur vide letter under reference (1) has submitted a proposal for the subjected work and PD, NHAI, PIU, Jaipur has submitted the above proposal vide letter under reference (2) for approval of the Competent Authority, Highway Administration.

- The proposal is regarding permission for laying 12" Carbon Steel Natural Gas Pipeline from Km. 110+500 (Ghiloth RIICO Gate, near Ayur Herbal) to Km. 118+500 (Neemrana RIICO) along NH-48 and one no. crossing at Km 111+100 at Shahjahanpur, Distt-Alwar in the state of Rajasthan by M/s. Torrent Gas Pvt. Ltd.

Reference is invited Asst. General Manager TORRENT Gas Pvt. Ltd letter dated 18.05.2021 vide which said proposal has submitted to this office for laying 12" Carbon Steel Natural Gas Pipeline from NH Chainage Km 110+500 (Ghiloth RIICO Gate, Near Ayur Herbal) to NH Chainage Km 118+500 Km (Neemrana RIICO) along NH-48 and one no. of crossing at NH-48 Ch. 111+100 at Shahjahanpur, Alwar District Rajasthan

- The said proposal has been examined in Consultation with Independent Engineer 2. of the Project Gurgaon-Kotputli-Jaipur section of NH-8, M/s. URS Scott Wilson India Pvt. Ltd. IE vide their letter dated 22.09.2021 has recommended for according approval for laying 12" Carbon Steel Natural Gas Pipeline from NH Chainage Km 110+500 (Ghiloth RIICO Gate, Near Ayur Herbal) to NH Chainage Km 118+500 Km (Neemrana RIICO) along NH-48 and one no. of crossing at NH-48 Ch. 111+100 at Shahjahanpur, Alwar District Rajasthan.
- IE M/s. URS Scott Wilson India Pvt. Ltd. vide their letter dated 22.09.2021 submitted that:

The IE's representative has inspected the proposed site on 25.06.2021 for laying 12" Carbon Steel Natural Gas Pipeline from NH Chainage Km 110+500 (Ghiloth RIICO Gate, Near Ayur Herbal) to NH Chainage Km 118+500 Km (Neemrana RIICO) along NH-48 and

one no. of crossing at NH-48 Ch. 111+100 at Shahjahanpur, Alwar District Rajasthanand our comments are given below.

In this regard, NHAI has requested to examine the checklist, drawings & other documents of the proposal in the accordance with MoRTH/NHAI guidelines & as per site condition & submit the clear-cut recommendation along with Site Inspection Certificate to NHAI for taking further action.

In accordance with sub clause 43.1 of CA, the Concessionaire shall have right to the use of the site as sole licensee subject to and in accordance with the Concession Agreement, and to this end, it may regulate the entry and use of the Project Highways by third parties in accordance with and subject to the provisions of CA.

In view of the above, the Concessionaire was intimated vide 2ndcited to go through the contents of said proposal for premission for laying 12" Carbon Steel Natural Gas Pipeline from NH Chainage Km 110+500 (Ghiloth RIICO Gate, Near Ayur Herbal) to NH Chainage Km 118+500 Km (Neemrana RIICO) along NH-48 and one no. of crossing at NH-48 Ch. 111+100 at Shahjahanpur, Alwar District Rajasthan.and submit your comments / inspection report with respect to Ministry of Road Transport & Highways Circular no. RW/NH-33044/29/2015/S&R(R) dated 22.11.2016 & Ministry letter no. RW/JAI/RJ/PS/2017/UTILITY/GENL/1161-1189 dated 16.03.2017 for your review and comments.

It has also requested that comments on this matter shall clearly mention that whether the location of the proposed gas pipeline is in urban/rural area and other points which are not covered in Ministry Checklist but are necessary having regard to road safety.

The concessionaire's had replied vide letter no. 099 dated 22.06.2021 and given comments as per CA and there is no objection by them against this proposal.

We had gone through the contents of said proposal and examined the checklist, drawings & other documents of the proposal as per site condition. Our comments on this proposal are also given below.

Upon examination of the submitted documents, it has been noted that the applicant has submitted the checklist, drawings & other documents in accordance with Ministry's Guidelines issued vide letter no. RW/NH-33044/29/2015/ S&R (R) dated 22.11.2016 & Ministry letter no. RW/JAI/RJ/PS/2017/UTILITY/GENL/1161-1189 dated 16.03.2017.

IE has inspected the site along with M/s Torrent Gas Private Limited representative to check the physical availability of utility corridor at the desired stretch of project highway for the proposed laying of gas pipeline, it has been observed that, the proposed Gas Pipeline from NH Chainage Km 110+500 (Ghiloth RIICO Gate, Near Ayur Herbal) to NH Chainage Km 118+500 Km (Neemrana RIICO) along NH-48 and one no. of crossing at NH-48 Ch. 111+100 at Shahjahanpur, Alwar District Rajasthan. Therefore, the above said proposal has been considered from Km. 110+500 to Km. 111+100 RHS and Km. 111+100 to Km. 118+500 LHS, One crossing at Km. 111+100 (62.1m) at Shahjahanpur on NH-8 (New NH-48) (Delhi to Jaipur Road) (total length is 8456m) for granting the permission



under the jurisdiction of NHAI PIU Jaipur. Accordingly, the corrected drawings & checklist has been received from the applicant.

It has also been observed that some of the project facilities like Bus Bay, Entry/Exit ramp and Junction Improvisent have not yet been completed where the said gas pipeline has been proposed to be laid in the utility corridor of project highway.

After examining the subject proposal in accordance with MORT&H/NHAI guidelines and our observations/comments are as given below:

- a) The service road in this section has already been completed on both sides of project highway.
- b) The ROW width is 62.10 meter in this section.
- c) The Pipeline is proposed moreover on LHS side of project highway except a small length of 600 meter on RHS side.
- d) The Toll Plaza is fully functional at Km 115+400 at Shahjahanpur.
- e) The flyover has been constructed & functional for crossing of traffic at Km 113+200 & 119+485.
- f) The project facilities are as under. i. Bus bay at 113+350, 118+480 on LHS. ii. Entry at Km 109+100 & Km 114+500 on LHS. iii. Exit ramp at Km 110+100, Km 112+500 & Km 120+680 on LHS.
- g) The pipeline shall be laid within utility corridor at the extreme edge of ROW limit. The depth of at least 1.5 meters below ground level should be ensured by the vendor.
- h) The crossing of pipeline at 111+100 as requested should be done by HDD method. The depth may be considered at least 3 meter below road surface. While crossing through project facilities it should be ensured that the depth should not be less than 3 meter.
- i) The pipeline should follow the extreme edge of row with 1.5 meter depth at all project facilities locations.
- j) M/s Torrent Gas Private Limited shall be completely responsible to follow MORT&H & NHAI guidelines and relevant policy circulars during execution of above proposals.
- K) The land acquired & reserved for project facilities & ROW corridor on the LHS & RHS side should not be occupied by M/s Torrent Gas Private Limitedduring & after execution of proposal.
- k) M/s Torrent Gas Private Limitedshall be responsible to restore the project highway completely in its original position after completion their works.
- M/s Torrent Gas Private Limitedis responsible to ensure that no interruption or disturbance is caused to smooth movement of traffic on main carriageway & service road during works.
- m) It is to be ensured M/s Torrent Gas Private Limitedshall not damage any part of highway, service road and its facilities during execution of their proposal. If any damage observed, the NHAI/Concessionaire has the right to recover complete repair cost including penalties from M/s Torrent Gas Pvt. Ltd.
- n) The agency will be responsible for any accident/incident including fatal accident, if occurred due to their negligence at work site. It will adopt all safety measures to ensure smooth and safe passage of commuters.

o) The complete desired stretch of the submitted proposal are falling under the Rural section from Km. 110+500 to Km. 118+500 (Length 8000m), One crossing at Km. 111+100 at Shahjahanpur on NH-48.

We have also worked out the license fee and performance bank guarantee in favour of NHAI which are required to be obtain from the applicantM/s Torrent Gas Pvt. Ltd, Jaipur (Rajasthan) The amount for license for laying of 8063m Pipe Line along and across NH-8 section has been worked to Rs. 17,53,010/- based on the prevailing circle rates for the particular area as made available by the applicant duly considering under the category of public utilities for this case as per the guidelines of MoRTH.

It is calculated at the rate of \$\mathbb{Z}\$100/- per route meter for pipe of size >=300 mm dia/width total length of 8063 m in NH-8 (New NH-48) for Rs. 8,06,300/- on NH-8 (New NH-48) initially for a period of Ten years (extendable if required till satisfactory completion of work) as a security to comply with the requirements of conditions as per MORT&H circulars in this regard. The amount of the deposited for payment of Performance bank guarantee is \$\mathbb{Z}\$8,06,300/- in this regard. The detailed calculation sheet for working the amount for License fee and performance bank guarantee is attached herewith.

Keeping in view of the aforesaid points and present status of works in the site, it is recommanded that permission for the laying of gas pipeline of M/s Torrent Gas Private Limited may be accorded in favour of the Applicant except the facility locations mentioned above and the laying of gas pipeline in the balance locations can be carried out in the utility corridor portion of project highway and after completion of said project facilities by the Concessionaire in the said facility locations.

Hence, we are submitting herewith duly signed and sealed copies of checklist & drawings along with Inspection Certificate as requested by the Authority for taking further action as deemed fit in this regard.

- Accordingly, the proposal has been examine in this office and vide above referred 4. letter dated 08.10.2021 has requested to M/s Torrent, Jaipur to submit the License Fees of Rs. 17,53,010/- and Bank Guarantee of Rs. 8,06,300/- and desired documents as per Ministry Circular dated 22.11.2016. M/s Torrent vide above referred letter dated 20.10.2021 has submitted proof of deposition of License Fee of amounting of Rs. 17,53,010/-in Bharat Kosh vide Receipt No. 1210210011098 dated 12.10.2021 and Bank Guarantee No. OGT0009210059342 dated 18.10.2021 of Rs. 8,06,300/- of Indusind Bank Ltd. valid upto 17.10.2026 for the Performance Security of the said proposal. Copy of BG confirmation is also enclosed. The license deed amount has been calculated duly considering DLC rate of agricultural land near national highway of respective village (copy of certified DLC rate and its calculation are also enclosed) and assumed it a public utility provider. M/s Torrent has also submitted an additional undertaking for the said proposal vide their letter dated 20.10.2021 for any kind of additional license deed amount as when as it was demanded by NHAI/MoRTH within 07 days of receipt of notice.
- 5. Further, this office vide above letter dated 23.12.2021 has requested to submit the balance License Fees of Rs. 66,440/- and Bank Guarantee of Rs. 39,290/-. Applicant

vide letter dated 05.01.2022 has submitted the proof of deposition of balance License Fee amounting to Rs. 66,440/-in Bharat Kosh vide Receipt No. 3112210011746 dated 31.12.2021 and amendmend in earlier submitted Bank Guarantee No. 0GT0009210059342 dated 18.10.2021 to Rs. 8,45,590/- of Indusind Bank Ltd. valid upto 17.10.2026. The same is confirmed by Canara Bank on dated 03.02.2022.

- 6. Further, this office vide above letter dated 23.12.2021 has forwarded the said proposal to new IE M/s CEG Ltd. for re-examination the said proposal as per MoRTH guidelines. M/s CEG vide above letter dated 12.01.2022 has submitted that the said proposal duly signed check list and drawings with recommendation for issuing permission.
- 7. In view of the above, the said proposal is seems to be found in order as per the prevailing site conditions. Duly signed checklist & drawings by undersigned is enclosed with the proposal and recommended to grant permission for laying 12" Carbon Steel Natural Gas Pipeline from NH Chainage Km 110+500 (Ghiloth RIICO Gate, Near Ayur Herbal) to NH Chainage Km 118+500 Km (Neemrana RIICO) along NH-48 and one no. of crossing at NH-48 Ch. 111+100 at Shahjahanpur, Alwar District Rajasthan.

The proposal is recommended for approval of Competent Authority.
