**Invitation of Public Comments**

**Sub:** Application for the final permission for construction and use of approaches/access road for proposed retail outlet at old NH -3 (NEW NH -46), Ch. 100.956 & 335.426, LHS part of survey no. 105/2/1 Khas/2 Part of 105/1 Village Gader, Tehsil & District-Guna in the State of Madhya Pradesh-Reg.

Please refer M/s IOCL, Bhopal letter dated 23.07.2019 vide which proposal for final completion certificate has been received from applicant.

2. In the subject captioned proposal provisional NOC was issued on 08.02.2017 and 1<sup>st</sup> EOT was granted up to 08.02.2018 and 2<sup>nd</sup> EOT was granted up to 08.02.2019. As per para 11 of the policy circular dated 24.07.2013 and amendment dated 01.12.2014 from MORTH in the said policy dated 24.07.2013, a total period of 2 years may be allowed for construction of the retail outlet. Thus, the maximum extension of time has already been granted in the subject captioned retail outlet for construction. The proposal for final completion certificate has been received from applicant on 23.07.2019, thus an additional EOT from 09.02.2019 to 22.07.2019 is required.

3. PD-PIU Gwalior, NHAI vide letter no. 15424 dated 03.06.2020 has recommended to this office the subject captioned proposal for issuance of Final Permission in the proposal after necessary rectification at site.

4. MoRTH letter dated 16.03.2016 provides that in case of non-fulfilment of criteria of construction with a year of NOC shall be relaxation to the norm and the proposal shall be uploaded for a period of 60 days for invitation of public comments. Thus, the instant proposal is being considered under relaxation on account of required extension of time for construction of Retail Outlet.

5. In view of the above, the subject captioned proposal is being uploaded for invitation of public comments for a period of 60 days on account of non-fulfilment of condition of construction with in the stipulated period. The comments of public on the above mentioned proposal is invited in the prescribed proforma Form-A (Copy enclosed) and may be sent to the address mentioned below:
