Sir,

This is in reference to your application for Annual Pre-Qualification (RFAQ-2014); the result of which was declared and uploaded on Ministry's website ([www.morth.gov.in](http://www.morth.gov.in)) vide Ministry's letter referred at sl.no. (i) above.

Subsequently, requests have been received from some of the applicants for enhancement of their Eligibility Limit based on their further experiences and also due to inclusion of OMT projects in evaluation. Eligibility Limit of the applicants as declared by Ministry's letter no. NH/37010/1/2014-EAP dated 13.03.2015 was fixed based on the facts provided by the applicants in their applications and based on the principles/criteria prevalent at the time of evaluation. Subsequent changes in the principles/criteria for evaluation or update in the eligibility of applicant would require further evaluation and changes in the Eligibility Limit which would be an endless exercise in limited period of one year. As such it has been decided that the declared Eligibility Limit of the applicants would not be changed. It is advised that at the time of applying for an individual project you may submit detailed documents to the Authority for further evaluation of your enhanced Eligibility Limit and the limit evaluated by the Authority at this stage would be considered for that individual project. This issues with approval of competent authority in the Ministry.
