## Invitation of public comments

Sub.: Proposal for provisional NOC for access permission to the proposed retail outlet of M/s Indian Oil Corporation Limited on NH-28 (New NH No.27) in Km. 25 (Ch.24.891, RHS) Village - Darapur, Tehsil - Nawabganj & District - Barabanki in the State of Uttar Pradesh - Reg.

The Regional Officer, UP-East, NHAI, Varanasi vide letter no. 14011/42/RO/UP(E)/2017/400 dated 08.02.2019 has submitted a proposal, for provisional NOC for access road permission to the retail outlet mentioned in subject. Subsequently, M/s Indian Oil Corporation Limited vide letter no.BBK/NH-27/2018-19 dated 15.03.2019 has submitted license fee vide DD no.158081 dated 14.03.2019 of Rs.2,68,020/-.

2. From the submitted location plan, it is seen that there is a gap in the central median towards Lucknow side at a distance of 157m from the proposed retail outlet. Further, it is noted that there are 3m wide road intersecting the main carriageway at a distance of 171m towards Faizabad side and another at a distance of 194m towards Lucknow side from the proposed retail outlet as against the minimum requirement of 300m, as per para 4.5.1 (ii) of Ministry's guidelines dated 24.07.2013.

2.1 The Oil Company has requested for relaxation in view of para 2 above. The reasons for relaxation as recommended by Project Director, PIU, NHAI, Lucknow are as follows:

(i) Applicant has proposed to construct a 7m wide and 750m long service road in addition to 70m long deceleration lane & 100m long acceleration lane with separator covering the intersections and median gap.

(ii) Median gap exists towards entry side, so proposed service road has been extended upto 300m from median gap.

(iii) Oil Company would provide all safety devices as required by the department.

3. As per the guidelines, issued by the Ministry vide OM No.RW/NH-33023/19/99-DO.III dated 16.03.2016, the Highway Administration will make available the relaxation application for public comments will be invited within 60 days from the day of uploading as per the format enclosed as Form-A (Annexure-I).
