With reference to above subject, the Superintending Engineer, NH Circle, Dharwad vide letter under reference has submitted the proposal for Permission to Crossing 110KV UG Cable in NH-4 Pune -Bangalore section Hubli- Dharwad bypass at km 414.180 and 414.760 by connecting 110KV Tarihal substation to Akshaya colony sub station.

The proposal has been examined and it is observed that, it is proposed to cross by HDD method by lay 160 mm dia. HDPE 630 mm² XLPE Cable at km 414.180 and 414.760 of NH-4 Hubli-Dharwad bypass.

The following details of are enclosed by the Executive Engineer (Ele), MWD Division, KPTCL, Hubli.

1. Chainage details of UGHT Cable crossing.
2. Crossing at km 414.180 and 414.760 shall be carried out by Trench less (HDD) method.
3. Method statement for trenchless crossing.
4. Ensuring no damage to road while execution of cable crossing.
5. Licence fee and Bank guarantee calculation sheet.
6. Original Agreement for laying of UGHT Cable.

As per Ministry letter No: RW/NH/33044/29/2015 S&R(R) Dated :22.11.2016, Para 4, Highway administration is authorized to accord permission for 'Accommodation of public and Industrial utility services along and across National Highways-Policy guide lines regarding'.
