Invitation of public comments

Subject:- Permission proposal for laying underground CI Sewer pipe line (Dia 600mm) along the road from Km 7/412 to 7/476, Km 8/317 to 8/466(LHS) & crossing at Km 7/412 & Km 8/466 of Avinashi - Avinashipalayam Section of NH-381 in the state of Tamil Nadu-Regarding.

The proposal is regarding request for permission for laying underground CI Sewer pipe line (Dia 600mm) along the road from Km 7/412 to 7/476, Km 8/317 to 8/466(LHS) & crossing at Km 7/412 & Km 8/466 of Avinashi - Avinashipalayam Section of NH-381 in the state of Tamil Nadu by the Commissioner, City Municipal Corporation, Tiruppur resubmitted to this office by the SE (NH), Salem vide letter No. 312/2022/JDO/NH dated 29.07.2022(received on 10.08.2022). The proposal has been examined and the details are as under:

2. The Right of Way in the stretch of NH proposed for laying underground sewer pipe line is varying from 24.30m to 53.20m. The carriageway width of stretch from Km 7/412 to 7/476, Km 8/317 to 8/466 of NH-381 both side aforesaid stretches is 14.00m to 15.60m. The Commissioner, City Municipal Corporation, Tiruppur has proposed to lay the underground sewer pipe line at edge of the ROW for a length of 213m by adopting open trench method along the National Highway and HDD method across the National Highway.


3. The Commissioner, City Municipal Corporation, Tiruppur, has furnished an undertaking to the effect that they will remove the laid underground sewer pipe line in future if required by NH wing of State Highways Department, Tamil Nadu/MoRTH, Government of India at any time for expansion of the NH at their own cost without claiming any compensation from NH wing of Tamil Nadu/MoRTH, Government of India and any right on the NH land. Further, mentioned that, the Commissioner, City Municipal Corporation, Tiruppur will also restore the ROW surfaces to its original condition soon after removal of the Public utility sewer pipe lines. Also, certified that the proposed underground sewer pipeline work will not affect the design, stability, traffic safety and future improvement of the proposed stretch.

4. As per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letter No.RW/NH-33044/29/2015/ S&R(R) dated 22.11.2016 the application will be made available for public comments and the comments will be invited within 30 days from the day of uploading the same in the web site of Ministry of Road Transport & Highways for public comments.
