Sub: Proposal for access permission for approach roads at km 69/014 to 69/049 (LHS) on NH-59 to the proposed Retail Outlet of Shri. Radhakanta Behera (Applicant of BPCL) at Mouza-Amath, Tahasil-Kesinga, Dist-Kalahandi in the state of Odisha-reg.

1. Shri. Radhakanta Behera (applicant of BPCL), i.e., the applicant, vide letter dated 11.12.2019 has submitted a proposal to this office on the above mentioned subject. The applicant is requesting relaxation from Ministry's guideline issued vide letter no. RW/NH-33023/19/99-DO.III dated 24.07.2013 with respect to an "intersection with NHs/SHs/MDRs/City Roads" is at a distance of 750 m as against the norm of minimum distance of 1000 m.
2. As per Ministry's OM No. RW/NH/33023/19/99/DO-III dated 16.03.2016, the Highway Administrator will make available the relaxation proposal along with Form-A on the Ministry's website (morth.nic.in) to invite public comments, for a period of 60 days.
3. In view of the above, comments of public, if any, on the above relaxation proposal are invited online as well as in hard copy by enclosing location plan, justification & Form-A. The same should reach to the below mentioned address within 60 days from the date of uploading it, in the website, beyond which no objection will be considered.
