Note on the Rally to commemorate the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi

- 1. Government of India initiated the yearlong celebrations to commemorate the 150th year of the legendary Mahatma Gandhi in India and across the globe on the 2nd October 2018. The Ministry of Road Transport & Highways is organising a Motor Rally to commemorate 150 years of Mahatma Gandhi's birth anniversary The rally would travel to and through places that are historically associated with Gandhiji, both in India, as well as in Bangladesh and Myanmar. The Rally would connect the places of significance in Gandhiji's life, and simultaneously take up advocacy on Road Safety concerns.
- 2. The Motor Car Rally is scheduled to commence on February 4, 2019 from Rajghat in Delhi which will also mark the launch of National Road safety Week. The Rally will pass through Sabarmati, Porbandar, Dandi, Yerwada, Sewagram, Jabalpur, Lucknow, Gorakhpur, Chauri Chaura, Champaran, Shantiniketan and Kolkata in India before travelling to Dhaka in Bangladesh. It will, thereafter, conclude at Yangon in Myanmar on Feb 24, 2019. It is envisaged that the motor rally will cover around 7250 km to reach Yangon. The rally is being organised by the Ministry in collaboration with Kalinga Motor Sports Club, which have earlier completed 3 international motor rallies under the aegis of MoRTH.
- 3. One of the highlights of the rally would be the crossing of the Gulf of Khambat by Ro-Ro vessels. The event is supported by the Ministry of External Affairs, Ministry of Culture and several other Ministries of Government of India. Receptions and Flagging off Ceremony and people to people interaction events are proposed to be held during the rally at various places of respected states, through which the rally will pass.
- 4. The aim of the event is to spread the great values of Mahatma Gandhi throughout its route. It will be a 'Drive for Peace' while remembering the great son of India in Bangladesh and Myanmar. It will also promote the message of safe driving on roads.
