Sub.: Proposal for NOC for overhead crossing of 132 KV Agra south TSS Acchnera line at Km. 18 (Ch. 17.730) on NH-11 (New NH - 21) Agra - Jaipur - Bikaner Road in the State of Uttar Pradesh - Reg.

- 1. The Executive Engineer, UP Power Transmission Corporation Ltd., Agra has submitted the proposal for overhead crossing of 132 KV Agra south TSS Acchnera line at Km. 18 (Ch. 17.730) on NH-11 (New NH 21) Agra Jaipur Bikaner Road to the Executive Engineer, NH Division, UP PWD, Etawah.
- 2. From the submitted proposal, it is seen that the height of both the pylons on which the proposed overhead line is hanging is 57.250m. The pylons on either side are erected at distance of 139.70m & 94.00m from the center line of National Highway. Further, it noted that the minimum clearance between the lowest conductor of the proposed line and NH carriageway is 21.22m. However, the proposed transmission line shall be crossing the National Highway at 90 degree.
- 3. As per the guidelines, issued by the Ministry vide OM No.RW/NH-33044/29/2015/S&R(R) dated 22.11.2016, the application shall be put out in the public domain for 30 days for seeking claims and objections (on grounds of public inconvenience, safety and general public interest).

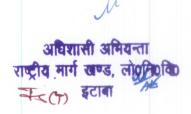

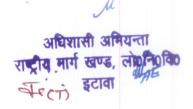

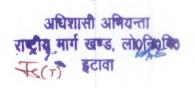
