Invitation of public comments

Sub.: Provisional NOC for access permission to the proposed retail outlet of M/s Reliance Industries Limited in Km.294 (Ch. 293.078, RHS) on NH-2 (New NH-19) at Khasra no. 194 & 194/3 at Village-Jonai, Tehsil-Jaswant Nagar & District-Etawah in the State of Uttar Pradesh - Reg.

The Regional Officer (CGM), UP-West, NHAI, Lucknow vide letter no. 19001/1/RO-W-UP/NH-2/NOC/ 3306 dated 29.06.2018 has submitted a proposal for access permission with respect of fuel station mentioned in the subject above.

2. From the submitted location plan, it is also noted that there is a 3m wide road adjacent to the proposed retail outlet. Thus, the proposal in its present form does not conform to Ministry's guidelines dated 24.07.2013, Clause 4.5.1.1(ii), wherein it is stipulated that the minimum distance of intersection with rural roads from the retail outlet shall be 300m.

2.1 The Oil Company has requested for relaxation in view of para 2 above. The reasons for relaxation as recommended by Regional Officer (CGM), UP-West, NHAI, Lucknow are as follows:

(i) Proposed retail outlet is abutting on 5.5m wide and 2100m long service road including D/A lanes to be provided by NHAI which is terminating at in front of site. So applicant has proposed to extend the NHAI service road in a length of 313m. Hence, there is a 3m wide road adjacent to the proposed retail outlet does not intersect with main carriageway.

(ii) Only cyclists/motor cyclists & pedestrians use this road. There is no LMV/heavy vehicles ply on this road without disturbing NH traffic. Due to service road, traffic will not directly intersect with NH carriageway.

3. As per the guidelines, issued by the Ministry vide OM No.RW/NH-33023/19/99-DO.III dated 16.03.2016, the Highway Administration will make available the relaxation application for public comments will be invited within 60 days from the day of uploading as per the format enclosed as Form-A (Annexure-I).
