Ltd. at Khasra on 569M, 570M, 576M, 571M, 572M, 574M, 575M, 568M & 580M on NH-24 (New NH no.-9) in Km. 38 & 39 (Ch.38.920.274, LHS), in Village - Chhijarsi Kulich Nagar, Tehsil - Dhulana & District - Hapur in the State of Uttar Pradesh - Reg.

The Project Director, NHAI, PIU, Ghaziabad vide letter no. NHAI/PIU-GZB/NOC/MD/ROLKO/Ch.38.920/E-365 dated 05.03.2019 has submitted a proposal, for provisional NOC for access road permission to the private property mentioned in subject.

- 2. From the submitted location plan, it is noted that the distance of the access of proposed property from toll plaza is 732 m, which is not conforming to MoRTH guidelines. Accordingly, it is observed that the proposal involves deviation from the Ministry's guidelines dated 24.07.2013. The Project Director has recommended to consider the proposal under relaxation.
- 3.1 The applicant has requested for relaxation in view of para 3 above. The reasons for relaxation as recommended by Project Director, PIU, NHAI, Ghaziabad is as follows:
- (i) In the justification submitted by the applicant it has been mentioned that the access to the private property is from the proposed 7m wide service road, which is extended and merging into the main carriageway before the toll plaza, there is no obstruction for the free and smooth flow of the traffic on main carriageway.
- 4. As per the guidelines, issued by the Ministry vide OM No.RW/NH-33023/19/99-DO.III dated 16.03.2016, the Highway Administration will make available the relaxation application for public comments will be invited within 60 days from the day of uploading as per the format enclosed as Form-A (Annexure-I).
- 5. In view of the above, comments of the public on the above relaxation proposal is invited to the below mentioned address:
