



Subject: Monthly Summary for the Cabinet for the month of July, 2019.

1. The Motor Vehicle (Amendment) Bill, 2016 which had lapsed on account of not having been passed by the Rajya Sabha earlier, was approved by the Cabinet in its meeting held on 24th June , 2019 and thereafter introduced in Lok Sabha on 15th July, 2019. The Bill was passed by Lok Sabha on 23rd July, 2019. The Bill with three amendments was passed by Rajya Sabha on 31st July, 2019. The Bill with amendments as passed in Rajya Sabha was again passed in the Lok Sabha on 5th August, 2019.
2. The Ministry has issued a draft notification GSR 523 (E) dated 24th July, 2019 for amendments to the CMVR for providing an enabling mechanism for scrapping of vehicles older than 15 years. The salient features of the draft notification are as follows:
 - i) The renewal of certificate of fitness in respect of transport vehicles older than 15 years has been proposed to be conducted every six months in place of the current provision of one year.
 - ii) Battery Operated Vehicles shall be exempted for the payment of fees for the purpose of issue or renewal of registration certificate and assignment of new registration mark. This was already issued earlier, but has been published again for legislative clarity to the amendments.
 - iii) It has been provided that the newly purchased Motor Vehicles shall exempted for the payment of fees for the purpose of issue of registration certificate and assignment of new registration mark subject to the condition that the motor vehicle is presented for the registration along with the SCRAPPING CERTIFICATE of the previously owned vehicle of the same category issued by the authorized scrapping centre / agency, and the scrapping certificate has not been utilized for any other such cases in the past.
 - iv) For issue of renewal of certificate of registration and assignment of new registration mark, the fees have been revised.
 - v) For conducting test and the grant and renewal of certificate of fitness for motor vehicles older than 15 years, the fees have been increased further.
