**Subject: Implementation of the new composite fee regime for
National Permit**

Sir/Madam,

As you are aware, this Ministry has already notified Central Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Rules, 2010 on 7.5.2010 for implementation of a new national permit system on payment Rs.15,000/- towards consolidated fee (earlier referred to as composite fee). The new system would enable the permit holder to operate throughout the country. Detailed procedure to be followed by the States / UTs for grant of national permit in accordance with the new regime has already been communicated vide this Ministry's letter of even No. dated 07.05.2010. Further, this Ministry is also in the process of finalising electronic system for grant of national permit as per the new regime in consultation with NIC which will be implemented very soon.

2. It has been brought to the notice of this Ministry that most of the States have not yet started implementing the new national permit system. Even some of the States are yet to issue appropriate instructions to their field agencies as well as check-post officials regarding the new national permit regime. It is a matter of regret that some of the States are not permitting smooth passage of the national permit vehicles granted from other States in terms of the new system. As a result, a large number of vehicles are queuing up along various stretches of national highways.

3. You would appreciate that the above national permit system has been devised on the basis of the decisions taken by the Transport Development Council in its meeting held on 16.04.2010. The State Governments need to take appropriate measures for implementation of the new system to ensure smooth movement of goods vehicles across the country.
