It is to submit that vide reference 1st cited, M/s. Indian Oil Corporation Limited, Tirupati has submitted a proposal seeking access permission to their proposed new MS/HSD Retail Outlet at Km 312/524 on RHS in Survey No. 239/2A of K.M. Agraharam (Eswarapuram), Puttur Town, Chittoor District in Tirupathi-Tiruttani-Chennai Section of NH-205 and the same was forwarded to the Team Leader M/s. Theme Engineering Services Pvt. Ltd., vide reference 2nd cited for offering comments and recommendations as per site condition.

- 2. In the reference 3rd cited, the Team Leader, M/s. Theme Engineering Services Pvt. Ltd., has submitted their comments by examining the above proposal with reference to the Ministry guidelines and certified that it satisfies the norms specified in that circular except the criteria the gap in the centre median from fuel station is 56m against the 300m for which relaxation has been claimed considering the access is from service road only.
- 3. Further, the Independent Engineer has informed that as per Concession Agreement service road of 7.0m width is proposed from Km 312/600 to 316/800 and in the instant proposal service road of 5.5m width is considered from Km 312/108 to Km 312/758 for taking access from the main carriageway. Hence, it is recommend to adopt 7.0m service road in lieu of proposed 5.5m service road in order to match with the provision of the Concession Agreement.
- 4. Considering the above, vide reference 4^{th} cited this office has requested to M/s. Indian Oil Corporation Limited, Tirupati to resubmit the proposal after incorporating the above observations of IE.
- 5. Now, M/s. Indian Oil Corporation Limited, Tirupati has re-submitted the proposal, considering the service road with acceleration and deceleration lane at 7.00m width from Km 312.108 to Km 313.388. Necessary undertaking has also been submitted that the above service road including acceleration and deceleration lane will be constructed at their own cost including future maintenance.
- 6. The proposal has been examined with reference to guidelines relating to grant of permission for Retail Outlet along National Highways, issued by MoRT&H vide letter No. RW-NH-33022/19/99-DO-III dated 24.07.2013. The site has been inspected on 04.03.2019 and a detailed inspection report is enclosed herewith.
- 7. Three sets of proposals which contains the following documents have been received from the applicant and duly signed by the undersigned (2 sets of originals and 1 set of Xerox) are enclosed herewith.



The site proposed by M/s. Indian Oil Corporation Limited, Tirupati seeking access permission to their proposed new MS/HSD Retail Outlet at Km 312/524 on RHS in Survey No. 239/2A of K.M. Agraharam (Eswarapuram), Puttur Town, Chittoor District in Tirupathi-Tiruttani-Chennai Section of NH-205 has been inspected on 04.03.2019 and the following observations were made

- 1. At the proposed site, the existing
- 2. ROW is 30.00 meters on RHS from the centerline of the median.
- 3. The is no SH intersection available at a distance of within 1000m from the proposed site.
- 4. The nearest intersection with rural roads of is at Km 312/524 which is at a distance of 350m from the proposed site.
- 5. No fuel station is available within 1000m from the instant proposal.
- 6. As per Concession Agreement, the service road is proposed from Km 312.600 to Km 313.600 on both sides and the applicant has proposed to provide the service road including acceleration and deceleration lane of 7. 0m width from Km 312/108 to Km 312/758 at their own cost including its future maintenance to match with the provision of the Concession Agreement.
- 7. The nearest median opening is at Km 312/446 which is at a distance of 56m from the proposed site. However, the access is from the service road only. Hence, the relaxation may be considered.
- 8. No user fee Plaza (existing or proposed) falls within 1 Km from the proposed retail outlet.

9. It is certified that the construction of Retail Outlet has not been commenced.
