Invitation of Public Comments


Subject: Proposal for access permission for approach roads at Km 5/590 to 5/630 (LHS) of NH-53 to the proposed retail outlet of M/s Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited at Mouza- Sambalpur, Tahasil- Sambalpur, Dist- Sambalpur in the state of Odisha.

1. M/s Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited i.e the applicant vide letter dated 23.08.2019 has submitted a proposal to this office on the above mentioned subject. The applicant is requesting relaxation from Ministry's guideline issued vide letter no. RW/NH-33023/19/99-DO.III dated 24.07.2013 as due to the "distance of proposed retail outlet from nearest railway level crossing" is 370m as against the norm of 1000m.
2. As per Ministry's vide OM No. RW/NH/33023/19/99/DO-III dated 16.03.2016, the highway administrator will make available the relaxation proposal along with Form-A in the ministry's website (morth.nic.in) for public comments for a period of 60 days.
