Sir,

In continuation of this Ministry's sanction letter of even number dated 4<sup>th</sup> October, **2022**, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to the placement of funds under **Flood Damage Repair (New) [FDR (N)]** as indicated in column (5) of enclosed Annexure to each States/UTs for incurring expenditure on the Maintenance and Repairs works of the National Highways under the jurisdiction of the States/UTs Governments during the Financial Year 2022-23.

2. The above expenditure is debitable to the following head under Demand No.86-of the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways for the year 2022-23:-

3054 -Roads & Bridges (Major Head)

01 -National Highway (Sub - Major Head)

01.337 -Road Works (Minor Head)
01 -Maintenance by Roads Wing

01.02 -Maintenance by Roads Wing Financed from Central Road Infrastructure Fund

01.02.27 -Minor Works

- 3. The amount should be spent for the schemes sanctioned under the head indicated in para 2 only. No expenditure should be booked/incurred above the financial limit prescribed in each sanctioned job.
- 4. While taking up works under FDR(N):
  - a) All ROs shall analyse works to be taken up under FDR(N) based on field conditions, interse priority and finalize the Action Plan for taking up of immediate restoration works in consultation with the concerned State/UT Government, to ensure traffic worthiness of NHs and restoration of connectivity at the earliest.
  - b) Efforts may be made to get the necessary restoration works executed under ongoing contracts for NH stretches, where projects have been awarded/ appointed dates have been finalized, including through variation or Change of Scope (CoS), etc.
  - c) Defects emerging, if any, on completed NH stretches under Defects Liability Period (DLP) may be got rectified through the Contractors as per provisions of Contract Agreements.
  - d) Implementation of immediate restoration works for Flood Damages, etc., on the stretches of NHs, on which maintenance contracts have already been assigned, may be got executed as a variation to such ongoing contracts under OR (DPP) as per inter-se priority and availability of allocations subject to prior approval of overall enhancement of such ceilings of works and annual phasing of expenditures for the State. Allocations for such works may not be made under FDR(N).

- e) ROs shall ensure that estimates under FDR(N) are finalised and approved within 1.5 times of the allocation communicated by Planning Zone at the earliest.
- f) All efforts should be made to complete works under FDR(N) within the current Financial Year.
- 5. This issues with concurrence of Finance Wing's Note No.31 dated 06.12.2022.
