It has been observed that the State Govt./UT agencies and RO (MoRT&H) are not reporting timely the surrenders in various heads of allocation even upto end of the financial year, due to this it becomes difficult to incur expenditure at the last moment. Therefore, all State Govt./UT agencies and RO (MoRT&H) are requested to ensure timely expenditure of allocated amounts under various heads well before the end of financial year. If any surrender of fund in any head is observed, then the same should be intimated to the Ministry well before the end of financial year, preferably in the 2nd week of the month of March.
