 - c. Defects emerging, if any, on completed NH stretches under Defects Liability Period (DLP) may be got rectified through the Contractors as per provisions of Contract Agreements.
 - d. Implementation of immediate restoration works for Flood Damages, etc., on the stretches of NHs, on which maintenance contracts have already been assigned, may be got executed as a variation to such ongoing contracts under OR (DPP) as per inter-se priority and availability of allocations subject to prior approval of overall enhancement of such ceilings of works and annual phasing of expenditures for the State. Allocations for such works may not be made under FDR(N).
 - e. RO shall ensure that estimates under FDR(N) are finalised and approved within 1.5 times of the allocation communicated by Planning Zone at the earliest.
 - f. All efforts should be made to complete works under FDR(N) within the current Financial Year.
