**Sub:** Revised allocation of funds under various heads of M&R and proposal to book expenditure under PR/IRQP, OR(C), OR(N), FDR(C) and FDR(N) in M&R purely on First Come First Serve basis in FY 2020-21 - reg.

Madam,

In continuation of this Ministry's letters of even number dated 22.02.2021, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President for revised allocation of funds as indicated in columns (4) and (6) of enclosed Annexure to States/UTs for incurring expenditure on the Maintenance and Repairs under **OR(N) and OR(C)** of National Highways during the financial Year 2020-21.

2. I am also directed to convey the sanction of the President to allow ROs/RPAOs to admit expenditure against sanctioned PR/IRQP, OR(C), OR(N), FDR(C) and FDR(N) works on purely first come first served basis henceforth during 2020-21 out of the total overall allocation as mentioned in column 5 of table in this para below for States/UTs; subject to the condition that office of Principal CCA shall ensure that overall expenditure for PR/IRQP, OR(C), OR(N), FDR(C) and FDR(N) is not exceeded at any point of time as these would ensure that bills pertaining to well performing States are cleared without any delay and there is no gestation period involved on account of the requirement to enhance their outlay at any stage in case the States/UTs allocation is/are fully exhausted as long as the total outlay funded by PR/IRQP, OR(C), OR(N), FDR(C) and FDR(N) for States/UTs for entire Country is not fully exhausted. In addition to purely first-come-first-serve, it is also proposed to restrict the expenditure incurred by the States/UTs under OR(C) and OR(N) to their respective allocation amount as mentioned in the enclosed Annexure.




