1. Ministry of Road Transport & Highways (MoRTH), Government of India hereby invites e-tenders (Global Tender Enquiry) through the Automotive Research Association of India (ARAI), Pune for supply & installation of inspection equipment & operation of Model Inspection & Certification (I&C) Centers. These I&C Centers are to be set up in ten various states of the country. Eligibility criteria is explained in the Tender Document.
2. The tender document may be downloaded from the website of Central Public Procurement Portal i.e. [www.eprocure.gov.in](http://www.eprocure.gov.in) and MoRTH's website i.e. [www.morth.nic.in](http://www.morth.nic.in) from 10:00 Hrs on 21.03.2022 till 12:00 Hrs on 18.04.2022. The cost of the tender document (Bid Processing Fee) is equal to Rs. 40,000/- (non-refundable) to be paid through Demand Draft drawn on any nationalized Indian bank in favour of Pay & Accounts Officer, Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, New Delhi / Fixed Deposit Receipt / National Electronic Funds Transfer (NEFT) / RTGS. The Bidders shall ensure the credit of payment of Bid Processing Fee in the respective account, on or before the Due Date and Time of Bid Submission. With respect to payment through NEFT / RTGS mode of e-Payment, the Bidders should upload UTR number receipt along with technical bid. The scanned copy of the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) in the form of Bank Guarantee shall be uploaded along with the Technical Bid. The EMD should be in the name of MoRTH equal of Rs. 90,00,000/- (Rs. Ninety Lakhs only) from Nationalized/Schedule Banks with a validity of six months from the date of opening of bid. The bid submitted without EMD and cost of tender will be disqualified.
3. A pre-bid meeting will be convened in MoRTH, Transport Bhawan, New Delhi at 15:00 Hrs on 28.03.2022. The duration of physical submission of Tender Document Cost and EMD will be from 18.04.2022 to 21.04.2022 from 10:00 Hrs to 15:00 Hrs. Date of opening of tender online (Technical Proposal only) will be 21.04.2022 at 15:30 Hrs. Other updated communication will be uploaded on the website i.e. [www.eprocure.gov.in](http://www.eprocure.gov.in) and [www.morth.nic.in](http://www.morth.nic.in) from time to time. 4. In case of response from local suppliers, purchase preference will be given to Class I local suppliers as per Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017, revised as on 16.09.2020.


