Reference NHAI letter dated 11.12.2017 & M/s L&T IDPL's letter dated 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2018 on the subject above. Since the concessionaire has given consent to extend the facility of Monthly pass using FASTag for local personal traffic @ Rs. 250/-per month (as a special case), the same may be considered for implementation. Further, the annual revisions shall be carried out as per National Highway Fee Rules, 2008. The local commuters may also be given the option paying the toll as per the existing arrangement (those who do not opt for Fastags) under the Concession Agreement. Further, necessary action may be taken by NHAI.
