2. 3. The matter has been examined in this Ministry and in light of the above mentioned decision of CCEA and PMO's reference indicated above, this Ministry proposes as follows:

- (a) All NH Projects along existing corridors, irrespective of the mode of delivery be appraised by a Committee headed by Secretary (RT&H), with representatives of Planning Commission and Ministry of Finance (Department of Expenditure in case of public funded projects and DEA in case of PPP projects). The approval for these projects would be accorded by Minister (RT&H), irrespective of the quantum of investment etc.
- (b) All Green field Projects within the TPC of Rs 1000 crore whether public funded or under PPP mode would henceforth be appraised by the above Committee headed by Secretary (RT&H) and approved by Minister (RT&H).
