Annexure - A

Activities on Toll Plaza etc. by all Road Owning Agencies to improve Road Safety like following :-

- i. At field activities like checking fatigue of truck drivers and educating them about Road safety.
- ii. To check rear side of Trucks and Tractor Trolley about Red light or Retro Reflective sheeting to avoid rear collision. Sticking red retro reflective tapes at Toll Plazas at night.
- iii. Special Drives on NHs to stop wrong side driving.
- iv. Special drives to stop overloading.
- v. NGOs to be involved for on-site Pedestrian safety and stop public in crossing roads other than FOB/PUP.
- vi. Some activities in Hilly areas are to be planned like installation of Crash barriers, Road safety furniture's.
- vii. Eye check-Up Camps for Drivers.

Activities by Enforcement Agencies including Traffic Police & Transport Commissioners to improve Road Safety issues :-

- i. Ensure strict enforcement and visibility as per MV Act upto grass root level.
- ii. Creation of awareness in Road users and school Children about Rules & regulations.
