<u>Norms for the Access for Fuel Stations, Service Stations and Rest Area along the National Highways – Approval to temporary approaches to retail outlets / rest areas for which approval to set up has already been granted - reg.</u>

Madam / Sir,

Kind attention is drawn to the circular issued vide this Ministry's issued vide letter No. RW/NH-33023/19/99-DO-III, dated 17.10.2003 on the subject mentioned above.

- 2. Instances have come to the notice where construction of approaches for access to fuel / service stations and rest areas along the National Highways (NHs) involving 4/6-laning of NH stretches have been approved by the Ministry. However, approaches as per approved drawing could not be constructed as the work on 4/6-laning is either in progress or in award stage.
- 3. In such cases where approval has already been accorded by the Ministry for access with reference to planned development of NH to 4/6-lane standards, permission for temporary approaches from the existing NH shall be accorded by the Regional Officer (RO) of the Ministry/NHAI, as the case may be, to facilitate operation of fuel / service stations and rest areas, in the intervening period until planned capacity augmentation of the NH is completed. While approving the layout for the temporary access it may be ensured that deviation from the approved plan are kept to the minimum extent possible. Further, layout of the temporary access shall ensure safe and smooth flow of traffic.
- 4. The concerned oil company or the owner of the fuel / service station / rest area has to furnish an undertaking to the effect that there would be no hindrance to the construction work of 4/6-laning of the existing NH stretches and the temporary approaches will be replaced by permanent access as per the approved drawings and its dismantling shall be borne by the concerned oil company or the owner of the fuel / service station / rest area.
