Subject : Accommodation of utility services like cables and pipelines for water/gas/petroleum products within National Highway right-of-way - Responsibility for ensuring conformity with approved plans

In continuation of this Ministry's letter No.NH-III/P/66/76 dated 19th November, 1976 it is reiterated that other authorities incharge of utility services like cables and pipelines for water/gas/petroleum products, should invariably obtain prior approval of the State PWD's/Highway Authority before undertaking any work of installation, shifting, repairs or additions/alterations to the utility lines located within the National Highway right-of-way. It has further been decided that it shall be the responsibility of the State PWD/Highway Authority to ensure that no work without such prior approval is carried out and that the execution conforms to the approved plans.

2. It is requested that the contents of this letter may be brought to the notice of all officers in your department dealing with National Highway works.
