DRAFT CIRCULAR

Sub: Scheme for inspection, monitoring and removal of unauthorized occupations on National Highways.

Sir/Madam,

All Project Directors of NHAI, General Managers/Deputy General Managers of NHIDCL and Executive Engineers of the State PWDs in charge of the National Highways have been conferred with the powers and functions of Highway Administrations under various Sections, including 26 and 27 of the Control of National Highways (Land and Traffic) Act. 2002 in their respective territorial jurisdictions by Notification S.O.No.3293 (E) dated 16.9.2019.

In order to ensure that National Highways remain free from unauthorized occupation, it has been decided that it shall be obligatory on the part of inspecting authorities of the Ministry and its implementing agencies to ascertain unauthorized occupation during inspection of National Highways and bring out the fact and extent of unauthorized occupation in the Inspection Note, directing the designated Highway Administrations to remove the unauthorized occupation under Sections 26 and 27 of the Control of National Highways (Land and Traffic) Act, 2002, read with relevant provisions of the Highways Administration Rules, 2004 (Annexures I and II).

The Apex Body of the Highway Administration shall also conduct a periodic review regarding status of the encroachments/ unauthorized Highways. MoRTH/NHAI/NHIDCL shall review the status of encroachments/ unauthorized National occupations on bi-monthly basis.

In modification of all extant circulars regarding inspection, monitoring and removal of unauthorized occupations/ encroachments on National Highways, it is directed that all the Highway Administrations shall conduct of ascertainment inspections for the purpose

The above designated Officers may combine an inspection under this circular with field visits/ inspections to be conducted for other purposes.

5. Apart from the inspection and subsequent follow-up action to be taken up by Highway Administrations and other authorities of all the agencies of the Ministry shall ensure that Contractors/ Concessionaires maintains round the clock vigil over their project lengths and remove unauthorised occupation or encroachment on National Highways as per the provisions of the relevant agreement cited below. Similarly, all Authority Engineers/Independent Engineers /Supervision Consultants shall ensure that such unauthorised occupation/encroachments are reported to the Highway Administrations as per the provisions of the relevant contracts cited below.
