NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the December 2014

G.S.R._____- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the constitution and in supersession of the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, Central Engineering Service (Roads) Group 'A' Rules, 2003, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement.-

(1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, Central Engineering Service (Roads) Group 'A' Rules, 2014.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Definitions.-In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,-

(a) "Service" means the Central Engineering Service (Roads) Group 'A' constituted under rule 3 of these rules;

(b) "Commission" means the Union Public Service Commission;

(c) "Government" means the Government of India;

(d) "Regular Continuous Service" means service rendered on continuous basis after regular appointment to a grade on the recommendations of the Departmental Promotion Committee or in consultation with the Commission, as the case may be;

(e) "Scheduled Castes" and "Scheduled Tribes" shall have the same meanings as are assigned to them in clauses (24) and (25) respectively of article 366 of the Constitution;

(f) "controlling authority" means the Government of India in the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways;

(g) "Committee" means the departmental promotion committee or Departmental Confirmation Committee or Screening Committee constituted under these rules to consider promotion, confirmation and Non-functional up-gradation and NFSG of officers in any grade as specified in Schedule IV and Schedule V.

(h) "duty post" means a post included in Schedule-I

(i) "senior duty post" means posts in the Pay Band of Rs. 156000-39100 with Grade Pay of Rs. 6600 and above;

(j) "grade" means a Grade of the service specified in Column 2 of Schedule -I;

(k) "schedule" means a Schedule appended to these rules;

(l) "Other Backward Classes" shall have the same meaning and applicability as laid down in Department of Personnel and Training OM No: 36012/22/93-Estt (SCT), dated the 8th September 1993.

3. Constitution of Service: All the duty posts included in the service as specified in Schedule-I shall constitute the Central Engineering Service (Roads) Group 'A'.

4. Grade, Authorised strength and its review-

(1) The authorised permanent strength of various grades of the service on the date of commencement of these rules, the number of posts in each grade and the pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto and the scales of pay shall be as specified in Schedule – I

(2) On and from the date of commencement of these rules, the authorised permanent strength of various grades of the service shall be as may be determined by the Central Government from time to time subject to variation depending on workload.

5. Members of Service: the following persons shall be members of the service, namely:-

(i) All the existing officers holding group 'A' duty posts on regular basis in the Central Engineering Service (Roads) Group 'A' on the date of commencement of these rules shall be the members of the service in the respective grades.

(ii) Persons appointed to service under rule 6.

6. Maintenance of the service.-

(1) The vacant posts in any of the grades referred to in Schedule – I shall be filled in the manner hereinafter provided in these rules.

(2) All vacancies in the grade of Assistant Executive Engineer (Civil) and Assistant Executive Engineer (Mechanical) shall be filled by direct recruitment on the basis of the results of the Combined Engineering Services Examinations conducted by the Commission, on the basis of educational qualifications and age limits decided for this purpose from time to time.

(3) Appointments in the Service to the posts of Chief Engineer, Superintending Engineer and Executive Engineer shall be made by promotion from amongst the officers of the respective discipline (Civil or Mechanical) in the next lower grade with minimum qualifying service as specified in Schedule II. Appointment to the posts of Additional Director General and Director General (Roads Development) and Special Secretary shall be made by promotion from amongst the officers in the next lower grade (s) with minimum qualifying service as specified in Schedule II.

(4) The selection of officers for promotion shall be made on the recommendation of a Departmental Promotion Committee as specified in Schedule IV.

7. Non Functional Up-gradations:

- (a) Whenever any Indian Administrative Service Officer of the State of Joint Cadre is posted at the Centre to a particular grade carrying a specific grade pay in pay band 3 or pay band 4 or HAG, the officers belonging to batches of the Service that are senior by two years or more and have not so far been promoted to that particular grade, would be granted the same grade on non-functional basis from the date of posting of the Indian Administrative Service officers in that particular grade at the Centre on the recommendations of the Departmental Screening Committee constituted in accordance with schedule V.
- (b) All the prescribed eligibility criteria and promotional norms including 'benchmark' for up-gradation to a particular grade pay would have to be met at the time of screening for grant of higher pay scale. [Annexure –I of DoPT OM dated 24th April 2009]
- (c) The other terms and conditions for grant of higher pay scale on Non-functional basis shall be as per orders and instructions issued on the matter by the Central Government time to time.

6. Seniority –

- (1) The relative seniority of the members of the service shall be the relative seniority in their respective grades as already determined before the date of commencement of these rules;

Provided that if the seniority of any such member had not been determined before the commencement of these rules, it shall be determined by the Controlling Authority in accordance with the general orders or instructions on seniority issued by the Central Government from time to time.

- (2) The seniority of persons appointed to various Grades of the service on and from the date of commencement of these rules shall be determined in accordance with the general orders or instructions on seniority issued by the Central Government from time to time.

9. Probation.-

- (1) Every officer on appointment to the Service by direct recruitment in the grade of Assistant Executive Engineer and Executive Engineer who are promoted from the post of Assistant Engineer (Group 'B' post) shall be on probation for a period of two years;

Provided that the controlling authorities may extend the period of probation in accordance with the instructions issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

Provided further that any decision for extension of probation period shall be taken immediately after the expiry of the initial period of probation and ordinarily within eight weeks and communicated in writing to the concerned officer together with the reasons for so doing within the said period.

(2) On completion of the period of probation or any extension thereof, the officer shall, if considered fit for permanent appointment, be confirmed in terms of the extant orders of the Government.

(3) If during the period of probation or any extension thereof, as the case may be, the Government is of the opinion that an officer is not fit for permanent appointment, it may discharge the officer or revert to the post held by him prior to his appointment in the service, as the case may be.

(4) During the period of probation or any extension thereof, an officer may be required by the Government to undergo such courses of training or pass such examinations or tests as the Government may deem fit as condition for satisfactory completion of probation.

(5) As regards other matters relating to probation, the members of the Service will be governed by the orders or instructions, issued by the Government in this regard from time to time.

10. Appointment to the Service.- All appointments shall be made by the Government in the duty posts in various grades of the service.

11. Posting.- Officers appointed to the Service shall be liable to serve anywhere in India or abroad.

12. Liability to serve in Defence Services or posts connected with the Defence.- Any officer appointed to the Service, if so required, shall be liable to serve in any Defence Service or post connected with the Defence of India, for a period of not less than four years including the period spent on training, if any;

Provided that such officer shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the expiry of ten years from the date of appointment to the service or from the date of his joining prior to the initial constitution of service or if he has attained the age of forty years.

13. Disqualifications.-No person,-

(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with the person having a spouse living; or

(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the Service:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

14. Powers to relax.- Where the government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

15. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxations in age limit and other concession required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

16. **Residuary matters.**- In regard to matters not specifically covered by these rules or any general, or special orders made or issued there under, the members of the Service shall be governed by rules applicable to other Central Services in general.

17. **Interpretation.**-If any question arises relating to the interpretation of these rules, it shall be decided by the Government in consultation with the Commission.

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NOTE:

(1) In exceptional cases, the Commission may treat a candidate, not possessing any of the above qualifications, as educationally qualified provided that the Commission is satisfied that he has passed examinations conducted by other institutions the standard of which in the opinion of the Commission, justified his admission to the examination.

(2) A candidate who is otherwise qualified by virtue of his having taken a Degree from a foreign University which is not recognised by Government, may also apply to the Commission and may be admitted to the examination at the discretion of the Commission
