- 1. Laying of 12" Steel Gas pipe line must be at the outer edge of the ROW on LHS of the existing ROW at a minimum depth of 1.50 m.
- 2. The trench should be filled up properly as per specifications & MORT&H norms and instruction of National Highway staff.
- 3. In case of any future development by widening to 4/6 lane the firm should give an under taking in bond paper that the laid 12" Steel Gas pipe line shall be replaced/shifted at their own cost within reasonable time of Pleramin intimation given by Highway authority.

- 4. During laying of gas pipe line besides the ROW of NH-234(Huliyar-Sira section) if crosses any cross road, after laying gas pipe line make the cross road to its original position for smooth flow of traffic.
- 5. During laying of gas pipe line make proper arrangements for safety and free flow of traffic under the guidance of police.
- 6. Proposed for HDD method from Km.288.800 to Km. 290.200, at built up area and road crossings.
